Blue bin | Paper

Obligation: tear boxes into small pieces!



- envelopes
- catalogues
- magazines
- brochures
- paper bags
- newspapers
- printed things
- writing paper
- cardboard boxes
- detergent cartons



Black bin | Organic and residual waste

- cooked leftovers
- filter bags / coffee grounds
- teabag
- peels / tropical fruits
- leftover bread
- fish bones
- paper wipes
- flowers and potting soil
- vegetable waste
- fruit peels
- food gone bad
- eggshells
- foliage
- ash
- rubber
- composites
- plastic buckets
- women's stockings
- cat litter
- ballpoint pens
- porcelain / ceramics
- sanitary pads
- garbage
- leather
- vacuum cleaner bags
- light bulbs
- candles
- plaster

Tip: Pack the waste in garbage bags and put it in the garbage bin. This helps against odor formation and contamination of garbage containers.

Tip: Please wrap damp or strongly smelling organic waste in newspaper.

Yellow bin | Recyclables

- metal
- foams
- composites
- plastic
- aluminum-trays, -lids and -foil
- fruit and vegetables-containers
- beverage and milk cartons
- plastic foils
- cans
- other foamed packaging
- vacuum packaging
- plastic bottles
- lids
- plastic cups



Municipal used glass containers

- bottles
- glasses
- jars

Extra tip

- batteries (collection boxes in stores)
- medicine (returned to the pharmacy)
